Unrestricted Expendable Bequest

Unrestricted Endowed Bequest

The property comprising this gift may, for investment purposes, be merged with any of the investment assets of the IPPF, but the gift shall be entered in the foundation's books and records as an endowed fund known as THE _____ FUND (the "Fund"). The Board shall use the endowment payout from the Fund to support the objects and purposes of the foundation.
